

Wholesale Acquisition Cost Information for Connecticut Prescribers VYVGART Hytrulo® (efgartigimod alfa and hyaluronidase -qvfc)

Connecticut law requires prescription drug manufacturers to disclose in writing to Connecticut prescribers the Wholesale Acquisition Cost (“WAC”) of marketed drugs when engaging in prescription drug marketing, as required by Connecticut House Bill No.6669.
